# Split (side-by-side) window function brings expression to the next level

The split-screen function of conventional XGA projectors overlap, with the sub-screen in front of the main screen. Our WXGA panels present perfectly parallel split windows, placing two screens side-by-side. When displays are simultaneous and identical in scale, comparative viewing is clear and effective.



#### Anti-Theft Features (password security, motion alarm, screen capture)
