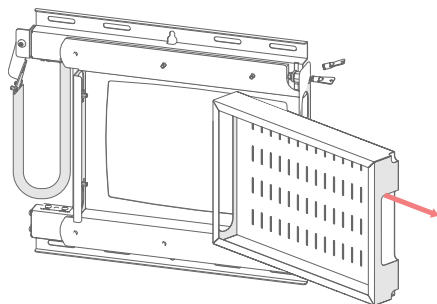


POSITIONING OF SERVICES

Do **NOT** position services within body of HTS or within cassette path. Dependant on installation positioning, see Step 4 - check before installing.

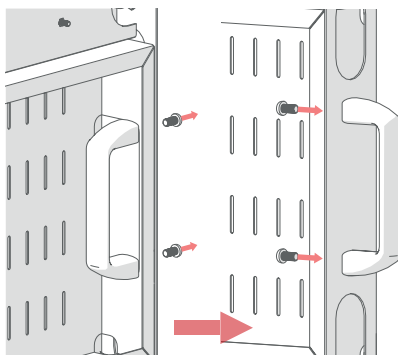
Recommended position - opposite side to the cassette/above and below HTS body. Screen size dependant.

Additional space for max depth 90mm - dependancy on installation positioning, see Step 4. Check before installing.



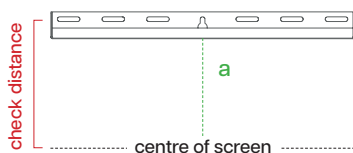
STEP 2

Gently pull on the lip of the cassette to release it. Remove it from the slider body. Populate with your media equipment.



STEP 1

Remove screws from handle in transport position. Re-attach handle (as shown above) using the same screws.

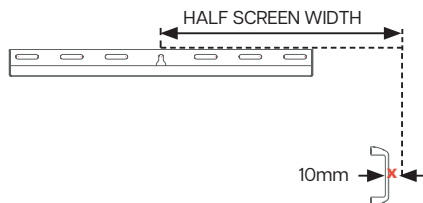

STEP 3

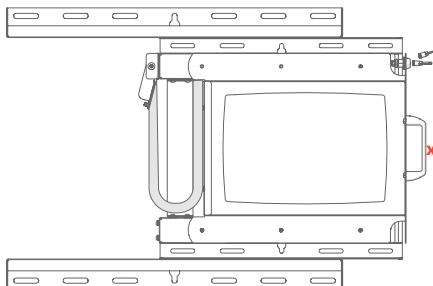
Mark where you'd like the centre of the screen to sit on the wall. Using the dimensions above, mark and then fix top rail to wall.

Please note - the dimensions above are based on VESA fixings being central to the screen. You may need to adjust if your VESA fixing points are offset.



STEP 4

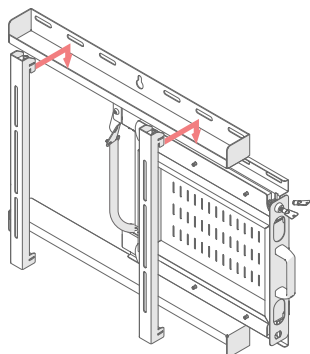
Once top rail is secured in position, measure half the width of your screen. From the key hole slot in the centre of the top rail, measure out the half screen width and then mark 10mm inside. This ensures that the handle will be hidden by the screen.



STEP 5

Make sure main slider body is closed and locked. Place main slider body so the top edge is touching the bottom edge of top rail. Position the body so that the handle is right up to the mark made in Step 4. Screw main slider body in place.

Position the bottom rail against the bottom edge and screw into position.

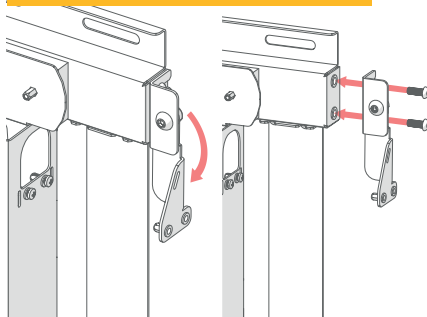


STEP 7

Thread cabling into the cable management system. Fix the arms to the rear of the screen and hook screen on to the top rail. Position and tighten fixings to secure.

Slide the main body out - the ends of the cables should now be reachable. Place the populated equipment tray into the frame, connect up and close!

CHANGING CASSETTE TO LEFT SIDE



STEP 1

Remove cable management pivot by unscrewing x2 M6 screws. Remove cable management chain by unscrewing all 4 screws.

Re-attach cable management pivot on other side using same screws. Allow pivot to swing round into position shown above. Replace energy chain.
